- Apply in the 9th grade
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Have ACT or COMPASS Scores of:
  - ACT
    - \* 20 or higher in English/Writing
    - \* 23 or higher in Mathematics
  - COMPASS
    - \* English 1101 qualifying score
    - \* Math 1112 qualifying score

- Have good attendance
- Have good discipline/conduct
- Be in overall Good Standing with their school
- Submit a completed academy Application
- Submit a transcript
- Obtain a recommendation form from administrator (school or district)
- Obtain a recommendation form from 3 teachers
- Write an essay 125-200 word explaining why you would be an excellent candidate for one of our academies.
